

## Bradford





- Bradford is the second largest Local Authority in West Yorkshire with an estimated pupil population of 110,000
- There are 220 schools in Bradford
- It is the second most deprived area in West Yorkshire

High number of resignations when potential Social Enterprise failed and difficulties recruiting

Only trainee = international student due to return to Hong Kong at end of placement

Surrounded by more exciting cosmopolitan or rural boroughs

> High level of EHCAs (even before this became a national issue)

No external applicants for posts

Dysfunctional SEN Assessment team / SEN processes



#### Planting the Seeds

- Assistant EP posts always attract many high-quality local applicants
- If we can support local people to become Eps, and look after them, they will come back to us
- Good success rate from AEP to TEP to Bradford EP
- Most Bradford NQ EPs have come through this route





#### Watch them grow

- Encourage local candidates to return for Y2 / Y3 placement
- Offer employed status to TEPs to provide living wage and employment rights
- Ensure balance of work
- Recruit as NQ EPs at early stage
- Provide enhanced nurture support to TEPs / NQ EPs







# Nurturing the crop

- Look at enhancements to attract people to be in Bradford eg HCPC fees / parking / social group
- Maintain balance of work and interesting projects
- Ensure a tiered management structure for career progression: specialist senior / lead specialist senior / temporary project lead
- Formal financial support to come to/ stay in Bradford




#### Marvel in what you have grown!

- Now fully staffed
- 4 local TEPs per year
- Expanded to 5 area teams
- 2NQ EPs per year (mainly home grown)
- 8 Specialist seniors / project leads
- 5 new local AEPs per year
